Subject: Section 536.200.2 Compliance

Section 536.200.2, RSMo 2000 requires agencies to make a filing with the Secretary of State if, after the first full year after implementation, the cost of the rule exceeds the agency estimate. The Commission Staff has investigated the cost of implementing the rule adopted by the Commission in this case and reports no information has been discovered showing the cost estimate published in the Missouri Register was inaccurate. This rulemaking, effective May 30, 2011, revised application requirements for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service identified in 4 CSR 240-3.510. Specifically this rulemaking eased the required documentation relating to an applicant's financial status. The rulemaking projected the proposed revisions will not create a public or private fiscal impact. No fiscal impact will have been created since the rulemaking simply eased regulatory compliance for applicants. Since the published cost estimates related to the changes in the rule have not been exceeded, no *Missouri Register* publication is required under Section 536.200.2, RSMo 2000.
