On January 23, 2006, Donald Taylor, Alex Walters, Minnie Henderson, Michael McClinton, and Stephen Carroll filed a complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE. AmerenUE filed a pleading on April 3, stating that it has settled the complaint with each of the complainants.
