ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET

On June 16, 1995, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Bell) filed a tariff sheet pursuant to the Order of Implementation issued by the Commission in this case on March 28, 1995. On July 3, 1995, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending the Commission approve the tariff sheet for service on and after July 17, 1995.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Bell's proposed tariff sheet is in compliance with the Commission's Order of Implementation of March 28, 1995. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheet filed by Bell should be approved for service on and after July 17, 1995.
