ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Matrix Telecom, Inc. (Matrix), formerly known as Matrix Telecom, submitted to the Missouri Public Service Commission tariff sheets bearing an effective date of March 1, 1996, designed to reflect the company's change of name, and to make changes in the company's tariff. On February 16, 1996, Matrix requested that the effective date be extended to March 9, 1996; the effective date was later extended to March 23, 1996. On the recommendation of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) Matrix submitted substitute sheets on March 7, 1996.

Staff reviewed the proposed tariff sheets and filed a memorandum on March 15, 1996. Staff stated that the proposed tariff sheets increase rates for existing services, establish separate interLATA and intraLATA rate tables, offer new services, include new tariff language, and substitute the new corporate name for the old. The new tariff sheets, titled P.S.C. Mo. No. 2, will replace Matrix's current tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1. Staff stated that it had no objection to the proposed tariff and recommended that the Commission approve the tariff sheets submitted on January 29, 1996, and amended on March 7, 1996, to become effective on March 23, 1996.

Having considered Matrix's proposed tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the company's proposed tariff sheets are reasonable. The proposed tariff sheets submitted on January 29, 1996, and amended on March 7, 1996, should be approved to become effective on March 23, 1996.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed by Matrix Telecom, Inc. on January 29, 1996, is approved to become effective on March 23, 1996. The tariff sheets approved are:
