ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On January 3, 1996 AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) submitted a proposed tariff sheet to reinstate its operator services promotion which had expired on December 31, 1995. AT&T stated that the promotion was allowed to expire in error and for that reason it requested expedited review of this request in order "to keep customer interruption time at a minimum". This case was created to address that request.

If approved, the operator services promotion will remain effective until its expiration date of May 7, 1996. The promotion offers customers who utilize AT&T operator services a discounted per minute rate on qualifying calls. The Commission has previously approved this promotion in Case No. TT-95-340.

On January 9, 1996 the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of the proposed tariff sheet. The tariff sheet reflects an effective date of February 2, 1996 and Staff has recommended approval prior to that date for the reasons stated by AT&T. Staff has stated it is unaware of any other filings which would be affected by this proposal.

The Commission has reviewed the application, the Staff
Memorandum and the entirety of the file and finds that the tariff sheet
complies with state regulations and is consistent with the tariff sheets

previously approved for the same service. Therefore, the Commission finds the proposed tariff sheet is in the public interest and should be approved prior to the February 2, 1996 effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet submitted by AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. on January 3, 1996 is hereby approved for service on and after January 25, 1996:
