## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

This order approves the tariff filed in compliance with the Commission's previous order and cancels the certificates and tariffs of companies that will no longer be doing business in Missouri.

The Commission approved a series of merger transactions that allowed Qwest Communications Corporation (QCC), and its affiliates, LCI International Telecom Corp., Phoenix Network, Inc., and USLD Communications, Inc., to complete a corporate restructuring. As part of that order, the Commission directed QCC to file revisions to its tariff to provide for services to LCI International Telecom Corp. and Phoenix Network, Inc.'s customers. QCC was directed to file those revisions no later than 30 days following the consummation of the merger. On January 8, 2002, QCC notified the Commission that the mergers had been completed. On January 30, 2002, QCC filed the tariff revisions with a proposed effective date of March 4, 2002.

The Commission's Staff reviewed Tariff No. 200200610 and filed a recommendation on February 7, 2002. Staff stated that the tariff filing was in compliance with the Commission's order. Staff recommended that the tariff sheets be approved. Staff

had previously recommended that the certificates and tariff sheets of LCI International Telecom Corp. and Phoenix Network, Inc., be canceled simultaneously with QCC's tariff and certificates becoming effective.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the tariff revisions are in compliance with the Commission's order. Therefore, the Commission will approve the tariff as amended to become effective as ordered below. The Commission will also order that the tariff and certificates of LCI International Telecom Corp. and Phoenix Network, Inc., shall be canceled.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the tariff filed by Qwest Communications Corporation on January 30,
 2002, is approved to become effective on March 4, 2002. The tariff pages approved are:
