ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On July 27, 1990, the Commission issued an Order Of Implementation approv-
ing the provision of community optional service (COS) from Southwestern Bell Tele-
phone Company's (SWB) Hillsboro exchange to SWB's St. Louis metropolitan calling
area. On December 14, 1990, SWB filed tariffs to provide service on the COS route
for which implementation was approved. On December 31, 1990, Commission Staff filed
a memorandum recommending the Commission approve the tariffs for service on or after
January 15, 1991.

The Commission will approve the tariff pursuant to its Order Of Implementa-
tion and the order in Case No. TO-90-232 approving the implementation of Phase II COS
routes. The route in this case is one of the routes to be implemented in Phase II.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to
implement service from its Hillsboro exchange to its St. Louis metropolitan calling
area be hereby approved for service on or after January 15, 1991.
2. That this order shall become effective on the 15th day of January,
1991.
