## ORDER CANCELING SERVICE AUTHORITY

On March 25, 1994, the Commission granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services to Total Telecommunications, Inc. (TTI). On October 18, 1995, TTI filed a written request signed by Jennifer L. Desmond, TTI's attorney, to cancel its certificate of service authority. TTI currently has fewer than ten customers.

On October 26, 1995, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum concerning TTI's request. Staff recommends the Commission cancel TTI's certificate and its accompanying tariff. Staff also recommends the Commission allow TTI ample time to notify its customers of the cancellation of its services.

Upon review of TTI's request and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds TTI's certificate of service authority and tariff should be canceled. The Commission also finds TTI should provide its customers with at least 30-days notice of the discontinuance of its service.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority and tariff of Total Telecommunications, Inc. are hereby canceled.

- 2. That Total Telecommunications, Inc. shall notify its customers of the discontinuance of its service within fifteen (15) days after the issuance of this Order.
- 3. That this Order shall become effective on December 15, 1995.
