ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

On May 19, 1995, the Commission issued an order authorizing its Management Services Department Staff to conduct a focused management audit of Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation (Chariton). The audit was to focus on selected management processes including policies, systems, procedures and practices with an in-depth review of executive management and planning, field operations, customer service and financial management. On March 4, 1993, Staff filed its Management Audit report and Chariton's Implementation Plan. On January 18, 1995, Staff filed an Implementation Review and on September 13, 1995, a motion to close the docket.

The Commission has reviewed the Implementation Review and will grant Staff's motion. In its audit Staff made seven recommendations concerning Chariton's operations. The Implementation Review indicates that no further action is anticipated regarding the recommendations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That this docket is hereby closed.

2. That this order shall become effective on the 11th day of
October, 1995.
