ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On December 31, 1991, the Commission issued a Report and Order in this case granting a certificate of convenience and necessity to Union Electric Company to construct, operate and maintain 700 feet of 161 Kilowatt (kv) transmission line in the City of Linn Creek. On January 13, 1992, the City of Linn Creek filed an application for rehearing on the issues in this case.

The Commission, pursuant to Section 386.500, RSMo 1986, shall grant a rehearing "if in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." The Commission has considered the reasons for rehearing raised by the City of Linn Creek and finds that they do not constitute sufficient reason to order a rehearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the City of Linn Creek's Application for Rehearing be hereby denied.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
