ORDER DENYING REHEARING

On May 4, 1990, the Commission issued an order in which it approved certain tariff sheets of Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation (Chariton) implementing community optional service (COS) and rejected certain tariff sheets as not necessary nor in compliance with the Commission Report And Order in this case. On May 9, 1990 Chariton filed a motion requesting the Commission set a hearing to consider the rejected tariff sheets or grant a rehearing of the Commission's May 4 order.

The Commission will not grant a rehearing of its May 4 order. Chariton's motion is filed beyond the effective date of the order, May 9, 1990. In addition, the May 4 order approved tariffs to implement the Commission's Report And Order. The tariff sheets filed did not comply with that Report And Order.

The Commission will not grant a hearing of the rejected tariffs in this docket. The tariffs approved have become effective on May 9, 1990. There is no provision for granting a hearing in this matter without granting a rehearing, which the Commission has denied.

To bring this matter before the Commission for consideration, Chariton should refile its tariffs with the rejected provisions with a 30-day effective date. The Commission will then suspend the proposed tariffs and set the matter for hearing.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the motions for hearing and rehearing of Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation is hereby denied.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
