ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR NAME CHANGE

By application, as amended August 20, 1990, Applicants seek a change of
name from Com-Link 21 Inc. to LDDS of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a LDDS Communications.

The application recites the following: Com-Link 21 Inc. (Com-Link) was
granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a
telecommunications reseller in the State of Missouri in Case No. TM-84-223.

In Case No. TM-88-189, the Commission approved the acquisition of all of
the outstanding stock of Com-Link by LDDS Communications, Inc.

On approximately April 17, 1990, Com-Link filed with the Missouri Secretary
of State a change of name to LDDS of Missouri, Inc.

On approximately April 19, 1990, LDDS of Missouri, Inc. registered a
fictitious name of LDDS Communications with the Missouri Secretary of State.

By the instant application the Applicants seek to have LDDS of Missouri,
Inc., d/b/a LDDS Communications as the correct name of the surviving entity. LDDS of
Missouri, Inc., d/b/a LDDS Communications also seeks permission to file substituted
tariff sheets showing LDDS of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a LDDS Communications as the
service provider.

The Commission Staff has filed a recommendation that the authority be
approved to properly reflect the identity of the actual service provider.

In the Commission's opinion the application presented should be approved.

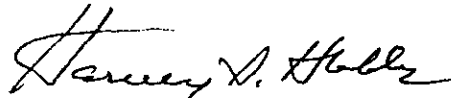
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a telecommunications reseller in the State of Missouri previously held by Com-Link 21, Inc., be and is, hereby transferred to LDDS of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a LDDS Communications.

2. LDDS of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a LDDS Communications shall file substitute tariffs reflecting the service previously rendered by Com-Link 21, Inc., which may bear an effective date for service rendered on and after the effective date of this Order.

3. That this Order shall become effective on the 4th day of October, 1990.
