**NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT**  
**AND CLOSING CASE**

Issue Date: May 9, 2007

On November 27, 2006, Eva Owen filed a complaint with the Commission against Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE. AmerenUE filed its answer to the complaint on December 29, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Report on January 3, 2007.

On May 7, 2007, prior to the filing of any testimony or the admission of any evidence, Ms. Owen filed a Motion to Dismiss her complaint stating that all disputes between the parties have been resolved and that all parties of record had been served with a copy of her motion.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss its complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered. Since no prepared testimony or oral

evidence has been offered in this case, Ms. Owen can dismiss her complaint without seeking Commission approval to do so. Accordingly, Ms. Owen's Motion to Dismiss will be treated as a Notice of Dismissal. The Commission acknowledges that Ms. Owen has voluntarily dismissed her complaint. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
