## ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 9, 2007, the Commission's Staff filed a jointly proposed procedural schedule on behalf of the parties. On March 13, 2007, the Commission issued an order adopting the procedural schedule as proposed. That procedural schedule included an evidentiary hearing on April 26, 2007.

On April 26, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule in this case. In support of its motion, Ameren stated that it had reached an agreement in principal with Ms. Owen to resolve this Complaint. Ameren asked the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule to allow the Company and Ms. Owen time to finalize the agreement and, if appropriate, for Ms. Owen to withdraw her complaint. The regulatory law judge assigned to this case contacted Ms. Owen to confirm she did not object to the suspension of the proposed procedural schedule. The Commission finds Ameren's request to be reasonable and will grant it.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The procedural schedule currently in place in this case is suspended.
- 2. In the event the Complaint is not dismissed on or before May 25, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE will file a status report on that date.
