ORDER NOTING CORPORATE NAME CHANGE AND CLOSING DOCKET

This docket was established to receive a letter from United Telephone Long  
Distance Company of the Midwest (UTLD) informing the Commission that it has changed  
its corporate name to United Teleservices, Inc. (UTI). UTI informs the Commission  
that it has registered with the Missouri Secretary of State the fictitious name of  
United Telephone Long Distance Company of the Midwest and will continue to provide  
long distance telecommunications services in this state under this fictitious name.

Since UTLD's tariffs on file with this Commission are and have been since  
their inception under the name of United Telephone Long Distance Company of the  
Midwest, the Commission determines that it is unnecessary for UTLD to adopt its  
tariffs under its new corporate name since UTLD will continue to provide service in  
this state under the name it has used since it began service. Since no further  
action is contemplated in this case the Commission will close this docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That this docket be closed hereby.
2. That this order shall become effective on the 29th day of October,  
1991.
