# ORDER RESETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Laclede Gas Company (Laclede) filed an application for an order authorizing its plan to restructure, merge and form subsidiary companies on December 1, 2000. On December 29, 2000, an application to intervene was filed by Paper, Allied-Industrial, Chemical, and Energy Workers Local No. 5-6, AFL-CIO (Local 5-6), and Paper, Allied-Industrial, Chemical, and Energy Workers Local No. 5-194, AFL-CIO (Local 5-194), which the Commission granted on February 13, 2001. On the same day, the Commission set a prehearing conference for February 27, 2001, and directed that a proposed procedural schedule be filed no later than March 6, 2001.

The parties have since agreed to reset the prehearing conference for March 13, 2001. The proposed procedural schedule shall therefore be due by March 20, 2001.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the prehearing conference previously scheduled herein for February 27, 2001, is canceled.

2. That the parties need not file a proposed procedural schedule on or before March 6, 2001.

4. That the parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than March 20, 2001.
