**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On July 18, 2005, SPB Holdings, LLC, d/b/a State Park Village Wastewater Treatment System, applied with the Commission requesting authority to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system in an unincorporated portion of Johnson County, Missouri. On July 25, the Commission issued an Order and Notice. In that notice, the Commission ordered its Staff to file a status report no later than October 24.

On October 24, Staff filed its Status Report and Request for Extension of Time. Staff stated that it would like until December 23 to file its Recommendation. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties 10 days to respond to pleadings. State Park did not respond. The Commission will therefore take up Staff's motion unopposed. The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Request for Extension of Time is granted.

2. That the Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than December 23, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on November 4, 2005.
