On September 20, 2006, L.W. Sewer Corporation asked the Commission for authority to reorganize and convert to a nonprofit sewer company. In addition, L.W. Sewer Corporation asked that the Commission cancel its certificate of convenience and necessity.

On November 9, Staff filed its Recommendation. Staff recommended that the Commission order L.W. Sewer to file executed copies of the Articles of Conversion, Amendment and Acceptance and the related shareholder consent. Also, Staff recommended that the Commission order L.W. Sewer to file the proposed by-laws under which the proposed nonprofit sewer company will be operating. Upon L.W. Sewer filing those documents, Staff plans to file its recommendation regarding the application.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) gives parties ten days to respond to pleadings. L.W. Sewer did not respond within ten days; therefore, the Commission will take up Staff's request unopposed. The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. L.W. Sewer Corporation (Missouri), LLC shall file the documents listed above

no later than December 12, 2006.
