In the matter of the Application of Union Electric Company for a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to own, control, manage and maintain an electric power system for the public in St. Francois, Dunklin, Iron, New Madrid, Pemiscot and Wayne Counties.

Case No. EA-94-278

ORDER APPROVING AREA CERTIFICATE

On March 14, 1994, Union Electric Company (UE) filed an application with the Commission requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to own, operate, control, manage, and maintain electric power service generally for the Missouri Counties of St. Francois, Dunklin, New Madrid, Pemiscot, and Wayne, which represent a portion of the area formerly served by Arkansas Power and Light, and now served by UE. UE is requesting an area certificate, as set out in metes and bounds descriptions attached to its application. This application, together with attachments, is attached hereto and marked Attachment A, and incorporated herein as if fully set out.

In its application, UE states that it is currently serving the areas set out above pursuant to a sale agreement from Arkansas Power and Light to UE and with subsequent Commission approval in Case No. EM-91-29. In order to properly describe the current service area and correct any tariffs which might be in error as a result of the sale, UE is requesting an area certificate for a portion of the former Arkansas Power and Light area as described in the application and attachments.

UE states that it proposes to charge the same rates as are presently on file with the Commission and that all necessary franchises have been obtained.

The Staff of the Commission filed its recommendation in this matter on August 22, 1994. In that recommendation, the Staff recommends that UE be given a waiver from the Commission requirement under 4 CSR 240-2.060 which requires submission of a feasibility study and plans for future construction and financing. In addition, the Staff states it has examined sample tariffs filed by UE in conformance with its application, with corrections, and now recommends UE file tariffs similar to the corrected samples.

The Staff also makes the following recommendations to the Commission:

- That the Commission grant the waiver from 4 CSR 240-2.060(2)(A)9 regarding the submission of a feasibility study and plans for future construction and financing of new electrical systems;
 - 2. That the Commission approve the Application, as modified;
- 3. That the Commission order UE to file tariff sheets similar to draft tariff sheets as filed and modified in the application; and,
- 4. That the Commission order UE to submit to the Staff, maps reflective of the service territory approved in this Application.

The Commission has reviewed the application of UE together with the attached information, and has also reviewed the Staff recommendation in this case. The Commission finds that UE is acting in compliance with a Commission order approving the sale of the APL territory in the State of Missouri to UE and UE's continued service of that area. As full notice and due process has occurred in regard to UE's service of this area, the Commission finds no reason to require UE to comply with Rule 4 CSR 240-

2.060 in regard to feasibility, construction plans, and financing. This filing is simply to correct the filed tariffs to accurately reflect UE's approved service territory. The Commission will, therefore, grant the requested waiver. In addition, the Commission finds the issuance of the requested area certificate to be in the best interest of the public and will approve the issuance of the certificate as set out in the application, and order tariffs filed in accordance with those samples filed and modified with the application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Union Electric Company is hereby granted a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, own, operate, control, manage, and maintain electrical service to the area as set out and described in Union Electric Company's application, attachments and modifications filed in this case.
- 2. That Union Electric Company is hereby ordered to file tariffs in full compliance with this order, for Commission approval, no later than 30 days from the effective date of this order.
- That a waiver from the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.060(2)(a)9 is hereby granted to Union electric Company for the purposes of this case.
- 4. That, together with the above ordered tariff filing, Union Electric Company is ordered to file with the Commission such maps reflective of the service territory in this application as the Staff of the Commission reasonably may require.

5. That this order shall become effective on September 9,

1994.

Comes Now Union Electric Company ("UE") pursuant to Mo. Rev. Stat. §393.170 (1978) and for its Application for an area certificate for St. Francois, Dunklin, Iron, New Madrid, Pemiscot and Wayne Counties.

- 1. Applicant is a Missouri corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Missouri with its principal office and place of business located at 1901 Chouteau Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri 63103. It is engaged in the business of supplying electric and gas service in parts of Missouri and Illinois.
- Communications with regard to this Application should be addressed to David C. Linton, Union Electric Company, P.O. Box 149 (M/C 1310), St. Louis, Missouri 63166.
- 3. Applicant requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to own, operate, control, manage and maintain an electric power system for the public in portions of the Missouri counties of St. Francois, Dunklin, Iron, New Madrid, Pemiscot and Wayne Counties, which represent the area formerly served by

Arkansas Power & Light Co. (APL) for which it does not already have an "area certificate," as shown on the maps attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and described more fully in proposed tariff sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

- 4. Applicant is already serving the areas for which it seeks the certificate in this case pursuant to a sale agreement of rights and facilities from APL to UE. The sale agreement was approved by the Commission in its Report and Order in Case No. EM-91-29, dated September 19, 1991. Applicant believes it is properly providing electric service in the area formerly served by APL pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order. However, in order to properly describe Applicant's "certificated area," Applicant is requesting an "area certificate" for the area formerly served by APL.
- 5. Inasmuch as Applicant is already providing electric service to the general area for which it seeks this certificate, and would continue to provide the same service in the same manner as it is now doing if this Application were granted, there is no basis on which to conduct or compile a "feasibility study" for providing service to the area in question. Applicant, therefore, respectfully requests the Commission waive regulations requiring submission of a feasibility study and plans for future construction and financing of new electrical systems (4 CSR 240-2.060(2)(A)) as it did in Case No. EA-87-123.
- 6. In defining its "certificated area," Applicant followed the Commission's determination in its Report and Order in Case Nos. EA-87-159, EA-88-124 and EA-89-80; EA-87-159, EA-88-21, EA-88-33

and EA-88-113; EA-87-159 and EA-88-29; dated March 13, 1991. In those cases, the Commission determined that the Applicant's certificates should include "land sections in which UE has existing distribution facilities plus land sections immediately adjacent thereto." "Distribution facilities" included lines of 34.5kV and below.

- 7. Applicant would continue to charge the same rates for service in its certificated area as are presently on file with the Commission, subject to changes as authorized by law.
- 8. Applicant has a franchise to serve in each of the incorporated municipalities within the area in question and has a franchise to serve in each of the counties. See Affidavits of C. W. Mueller and J. C. Thompson, Exhibits 3 and 4, incorporated herein by reference.
- 9. Electrical service is also provided in portions of the area sought to be certified by the suppliers listed on Exhibit 5.
- 10. The names and addresses of ten persons residing in the area in question are listed on Exhibit 6 hereto.
- 11. An estimate of the number of customers already served by Applicant in the area in question is shown by county on Exhibit 7 hereto.
- 12. Applicant has previously filed a certified copy of its Articles of Incorporation and evidence that it is a corporation in good standing in Commission Case No. EA-87-105.
- 13. The granting of this Application is required by the public convenience and necessity in that Applicant is already

providing electrical service to the area in question; it would continue to provide needed electrical service to new customers in the areas in question and, unless this certificate is granted, there will likely be substantial confusion before the Commission and the Courts regarding the rights of Applicant to serve new customers in Applicant's service territory.

Wherefore, Union Electric Company respectfully requests the Commission to grant permission, approval, and a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to install, acquire, build, construct, own, operate, control, manage and maintain an electric power system for the public within the area described on Exhibit 1 of this Application and for such other relief as this Commission may deem just and proper.
