ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On February 1, 1993, GTE Systems of Missouri (GTE) submitted a proposed tariff sheet to offer custom calling and touch call promotions for all GTE exchanges statewide wherein the service connection charges associated with these services would be waived from March 1, 1993 to May 30, 1993.

On February 22, 1993, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum in this case recommending that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheet as filed. In support of its recommendation, Staff states that GTE has previously conducted promotions identical to the proposed promotion and that tracking of these types of promotions reveal that contribution is ultimately increased. Staff further states it is unaware of any other filings that affect or that would be affected by this proposal. Therefore, Staff states it has no objections to the proposed tariff sheet.

Upon review of the filing and its Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the tariff sheet, as proposed, should be approved for the time period of March 1, 1993 through May 30, 1993. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet is identical to promotions previously conducted by GTE.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet submitted on February 1, 1993, by GTE Systems of Missouri be, and the same is, hereby approved for service on or after March 1, 1993 to May 30, 1993.

2. That this order shall become effective on the 1st day of March,
1993.
