## ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On January 24, 1992, Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation (CVTC) filed proposed tariff sheets to implement rates, terms and conditions for interconnection of radio common carriers (RCCs) with CVTC's local exchange network. Because CVTC requested expedited handling of the filing, this case was established.

On February 13, 1992, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum in this case recommending that the Commission approve these proposed tariffs for service on and after the earliest possible date so that CVTC could respond to an RCC's request for interconnection as rapidly as possible. At the present time the proposed tariffs bear an effective date of February 23, 1992.

In support of its recommendation, Staff states that these proposed tariffs are similar to tariffs recently approved by the Commission for Rock Port Telephone Company in Case No. TR-92-152 and to tariffs approved by the Commission for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company in Case No. TR-90-144.

Based upon the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission determines that the tariffs filed by CVTC should be approved for service on and after February 20, 1992.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariffs filed in this case by Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation on January 24, 1992, to govern interconnection of radio common

carriers with Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation's local exchange network, be approved hereby for service on and after February 20, 1992.

2. That this order shall become effective on February 20, 1992.
