## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On July 10, 1990, the Commission issued a Report And Order granting

Americall Long Distance, Inc. (Americall) a certificate of service authority to

provide intrastate toll telecommunications service in Missouri. On August 6, 1990,

Americall filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel the certificate. Americall

states that it no longer wishes to provide service in Missouri and has not filed

tariffs to implement the service granted. Americall indicates further that it has no

customers in Missouri.

Based upon Americall's statements, the Commission has determined that the certificate of service authority granted Americall will be canceled. Since Americall has not filed tariffs and has no customers, there is no other action which needs to be taken.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the certificate of service authority granted Americall Long Distance, Inc., be hereby canceled.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on the 28th day of August, 1990.
