ORDER DENYING MOTION

On November 7, 1988, Teleconnect Company (Teleconnect) filed a motion asking the Commission to remove the suspension of its operator services tariff filed

herein. Teleconnect filed proposed revisions to these suspended tariffs on

November 2, 1988. Teleconnect asserts that these revisions should allay the concerns

of the Commission's Staff (Staff) as to Teleconnect's proposed operator services

tariff.

In support of its motion Teleconnect argues that no parties now object to the offering of its operator services in the State of Missouri. Teleconnect notes that the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) stated in the hearing that it has no remaining objection to the offering of operator services by Teleconnect in this state.

On November 9, 1988, American Operator Services, Inc. (AOS) filed its response in opposition to Teleconnect's motion. AOS states that there remain questions as to the operator services proposed by Teleconnect and that the lifting of the suspension would grant Teleconnect an unwarranted competitive advantage over other applicants seeking to offer operator services in Missouri.

On November 18, 1988, Public Counsel filed its response in opposition to Teleconnect's motion stating that prudency dictates that the suspension of Teleconnect's tariff should not be lifted prior to the conclusion of this case. Public Counsel argues that the Commission may desire to impose certain requirements or restrictions on the provision of operator services within this state which may be different from or additional to Teleconnect's presently proposed tariff. Public Counsel points out that this case is now in its briefing stage and should be concluded within a reasonably short time.

The Commission has carefully considered the motion of Teleconnect and concludes that it should be denied. The provision of alternative operator services in this state should not be authorized prior to the development of a cogent and uniform policy.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the motion of Teleconnect Company to remove the suspension from its proposed operator services tariff filed herein is denied hereby.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the 6th day of

December, 1988.
