

4. That Petitioner Zoltek Corporation shall file its Reply Brief on or before 4:00 p.m. on July 17, 2002.

5. That the Staff of the Commission may file a Brief, but need not do so, no later than 4:00 p.m. on May 28, 2002. Staff shall not file Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

6. That this Order shall become effective on April 26, 2002.
