NOTICE OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING PROPOSED RATE INCREASE

Based upon a request by the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC), a state agency responsible for representing the interests of consumers before the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission), the Commission will be holding a local public hearing regarding proposed changes to the customer rates of R. D. Sewer Company, L.L.C. (Company). The purpose of this local public hearing is to provide customers the opportunity to comment on the proposed changes to the Company's rates, and to bring recent service-related problems to the Commission's attention.

The day's activities will begin with an informal question-and-answer session starting at 11:30 a.m. – with the local public hearing starting at 12 noon.
