## Report on Mediation

COMES NOW the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes and Modular Units of the Public Service Commission ("Director" and "Division"), by and through the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Office of General Counsel, and for his Report on Mediation states as follows:

- 1. On March 27, 2000, the Respondent filed a Request for Voluntary Mediation. On March 28, 2000, the Director filed a response stating that he had no objections to, and was willing to submit to, voluntary mediation. On March 30, 2000, the Commission issued its Order Directing Mediation.
- 2. Counsel for the Director and Counsel for the Respondent have been discussing various issues and had scheduled a meeting to resolve the Complaint based on those discussions. During the course of this case, the homeowner's lender repossessed the home in question. To the Director's knowledge this repossession was unrelated to the case. However, this has further delayed this case. The Director has forwarded an updated inspection report concerning the home

in question to the Respondent, and the Respondent will review this latest inspection report. If the respondent does not then make repairs to the home to correct those deficiencies identified by the Director's Staff in a timely manner, the Director will request that mediation be concluded and the case set for a prehearing conference.
