The revised tariff sheets are designed to implement a general rate increase for natural gas service provide by MGE in the amount of \$32,416,997, or 4.7%, based upon MGE's total test year as adjusted revenue, excluding gross receipts and sales taxes. The purpose of this filing is to recover the increased cost of providing service to customers. MGE has constructed significant new gas service facilities and other costs of providing service, including wages and benefits, environmental costs and uncollectible expense have increased as well. The resulting revenue shortfalls have caused MGE's earnings to fall short of the level authorized by the Commission. Rates were last increased in April 2007.


