ORDER DIRECTING FILING

In the Commission's September 29 Agenda, with regard to the approval of Mill Creek Sewers, Inc.'s tariff,¹ the Commission expressed its desire to be informed of whether a company seeking a certificate to provide sewer service will be in compliance with certain federally inspired regulations. The Commission notes that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources has Orders of Rulemakings,² published in the November 15, 2005, Missouri Register, to be effective on December 31, 2005. The Commission presumes these regulations codify the concerns discussed in the September 29 Agenda.

On November 23, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Memorandum recommending that the Commission grant Timber Creek Sewer Company a certificate to provide sewer service. Staff' memorandum does not, however, inform the Commission of whether the company will be in compliance with the above noted rules. The Commission will, therefore, require Staff to provide this information. Further, the Commission will require

Staff to state whether the company's proposed rates reflect the cost of complying with the anticipated regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file, no later than December 22, 2005, a pleading as described in the body of this order.
2. That this order shall become effective on December 7, 2005.
