STAFF’S COMPLIANCE TARIFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, through counsel, and states as follows.

1. On January 21, 2020 the Commission granted MAWC a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for the Clinton Estates service area and ordered MAWC to file new and revised tariff sheets.

2. On January 29 MAWC filed revised tariff sheets IN 1.3; IN 1.4; IN 1.5; and RT 3.1 and new tariff sheets MP 19.1 and CA 18.1 in tracking number YS-2020-0120. On January 30 the Commission directed Staff to file a recommendation by February 10.

3. On February 5 MAWC filed revised tariff sheet IN 1.1 in tracking number JS-2020-0124. On February 5 the Commission directed Staff to file a recommendation by February 15.

4. Staff reviewed all tariff sheets and concluded that they comply with the Commission’s January 21 order, except as noted herein.

5. Revised tariff sheet IN1.1 is an index sheet, similar to sheets IN 1.3, IN 1.4, and IN 1.5. Although the Commission did not explicitly direct MAWC to file this tariff sheet, Staff believes that this filing is necessary in order to incorporate the new tariff sheets into the index. Staff also notes that in its order granting the Certificate of

Convenience and Necessity, the Commission directed MAWC to submit revised tariff sheets “that include [a]ppropriate index modifications.” Approving sheet IN 1.1 is consistent with this order.

6. In its memorandum, Staff recommended that tariff sheet R 13.4¹ be revised,² and the Commission ordered revision.³ Sheet R 13.4 describes the rules for pump sewer systems, and Staff initially recommended that sheet R 13.4 be revised to add the Clinton Estates system to the list of systems in paragraph 2. However, in making its recommendation, Staff overlooked the fact that sheet R 13.4 is inapplicable to the Clinton Estates system, because it is a gravity fed system.⁴ MAWC and Staff now agree that sheet R 13.4 does not require revision. For this reason, MAWC did not file a revised sheet R 13.4, and Staff moves the Commission to revise its order, deleting the requirement that MAWC file a revised tariff sheet R 13.4.

7. Therefore, Staff recommends approval of:

WHEREFORE, Staff requests that the Commission issue an order approving MAWC’s proposed new and revised tariff sheets filed January 29 (with an effective date

of February 28) and the new tariff sheet filed February 5 (with an effective date of March 6). Staff also requests that the Commission revise its January 21 order granting the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, deleting the requirement that MAWC file a revised sheet R 13.4.




