On April 8, 2021, the Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing in the matter of the application of Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) for a certificate of convenience and necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system in and around Hallsville, Missouri. MAWC's application seeks Commission authority to acquire the City of Hallsville sewer system. Boone County Regional Sewer District, the Staff of the Commission (Staff), and the Office of the Public Counsel are also parties.

On April 23, 2021, the Commission directed MAWC to file appropriate documentation to confirm the status of and describe any new rate structure in place or expected to be adopted by the City of Hallsville sewer system. The Commission also directed Staff to file a supplemental recommendation addressing whether a new Hallsville rate structure, if any, results in any changes to Staff's recommendation.

On April 28, 2021, MAWC filed a copy of Hallsville Ordinance No. 384, describing a new rate structure effective April 12, 2021. On May 10, 2021, Staff filed a supplemental recommendation, with three additional documents attached. The Commission has

marked the copy of the Hallsville Ordinance No. 384 as Exhibit No. 308. The Commission has marked Staff's supplemental response as Exhibit No. 309. Both exhibits are attached to this order.

The Commission will establish a deadline for any objections to admission on the record of Exhibit Nos. 308 and 309.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any objection to admission on the record of the attached documents, marked as Exhibit No. 308 and Exhibit No. 309, shall be filed no later than May 25, 2021.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
