ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

On May 23, 1990, Ozark Natural Gas Company, Inc. (Ozark) filed its Application for Order and Certificate of Service authorizing Ozark to transport and distribute natural gas from Aurora, Missouri to Branson and Hollister, Missouri, with distribution to intermediate points adjacent to the route in the counties of Lawrence, Stone, Taney and Barry, Missouri. On November 2, 1992 Ozark filed a Motion To Withdraw Application, stating therein that the original application routing for the transmission line had changed and that Ozark would be filing a new application with changed routing and changed proposed certificated service area. Ozark asked for immediate Commission action.

The Commission determines that the request of Ozark is reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Application of Ozark Natural Gas Company, Inc., for an Order granting a Certificate of Service for natural gas transmission and distribution service in the proposed service area therein is hereby dismissed and the docket ordered closed.
