ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

On January 16, 2001, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T), filed a Motion for Extension, requesting an extension from January 22, 2001, to January 29, 2001, to file its proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. AT&T states that gathering the necessary information has proved very time-consuming because the case has been inactive for so long and because some of the required documents had been archived. AT&T indicates that counsel for SWBT and counsel for the Staff of the Commission do not oppose AT&T's request for an extension.
