ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO COMPEL

The Commission issued an order on March 29, 1996, approving a joint agreement of the parties pursuant to 4 CSR 240-22, the Commission's Integrated Resource Planning Rules. As a part of that joint agreement, UtiliCorp United Inc. (UtiliCorp) agreed to take various actions. On October 8, 1997, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed a motion to compel responses by UtiliCorp to certain data requests submitted to UtiliCorp by OPC on August 6. These data requests seek information about the extent to which UtiliCorp has or has not fulfilled its commitments under the joint agreement. Of particular interest to OPC is the current status of UtiliCorp's analysis of demand-side resource programs.

At the expiration of the 10-day period for responses, no other party to this docket had responded to the OPC motion.

The Commission finds the OPC request to be reasonable and will order UtiliCorp to respond in full to OPC data requests Nos. 501 through 506 within 10 days from the effective date of this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the motion to compel filed October 8, 1997, by the Office of the Public Counsel is granted and UtiliCorp United Inc. is hereby ordered to respond in full and appropriate fashion to Office of the Public Counsel data requests Nos. 501 through 506 no later than 10 days from the effective date of this order.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 29,
1997.
