ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On June 24, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Newman Amusement, Inc.'s ("Newman") certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-94-13, the Commission granted Newman a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Newman filed their Statement of Revenue indicating the company has ceased operations and is no longer in business. Newman requested the Commission cancel their certificates of service authority. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service.

On July 9, 2010, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than July 19, 2010. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority

may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Newman Amusement, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide private pay telephone services granted to Newman Amusement, Inc., in File Number TA-94-13, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on August 13, 2010.
3. This case may be closed on August 14, 2010.
