1. On August 24, 2017, MPGA filed a Motion Requesting a Prehearing Conference, to which Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. (Summit) filed a response on August 28.
2. In its Motion, MPGA noted several pending items and motions, some of which have been pending for several months, and requested that a Prehearing Conference be set to discuss setting a procedural schedule to address pending motions and set the matter for evidentiary hearing in a manner that will best meet the needs of all concerned.
