## **SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND FILING DATES**

COMES NOW Tri-States Utility, Inc. ("Tri-States"), pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rule 4 CSR 240-2.050(3)(A), and for its Second Motion To Extend Filing Dates respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On April 16, 2012, Tri-States filed its Motion to Extend Filing Dates, stating to the Commission that Tri-States and Applicant Old National Bank were seeking a possible resolution of this matter and, to facilitate those discussions, Tri-States requested that the previously ordered filing periods be extended. By its Order Directing Filings issued that same date, the Commission granted the motion and ordered the following:
  - A. No later than May 21, 2012, Tri-States shall file a response to the application;
  - B. No later than June 21, 2012, the Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation on the application; and
  - C. No later than July 9, 2012, any party may file a reply to the response, the recommendation, or both.
- 2. Tri-States reports to the Commission that the above-referenced discussions exploring resolution of this matter continue, and Tri-States believes that an additional two-week extension of the above filing dates will facilitate the possibility of

resolution. Tri-States does not file this motion with the intent to unduly delay this proceeding.

3. Accordingly, Tri-States respectfully requests that the Commission extend the previously ordered filing dates as follows:

A. No later than June 4, 2012, Tri-States shall file a response to the application;

B. No later than July 5, 2012, the Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation on the application; and

C. No later than July 23, 2012, any party may file a reply to the response, the recommendation, or both.

4. Tri-States has discussed the filing of its Second Motion with Applicant Old National Bank, the Commission's Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel, and is authorized to state that no party objects to the granting of the relief requested herein.

WHEREFORE, Tri-States Utility, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission again extend its previously ordered filings schedule as proposed herein.
