
STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) and in response to the Missouri Public Service Commission’s (Commission) September 9, 2020 *Order Directing Filing*, files this *Status Report* and states to the Commission as follows:

1. On January 21, 2020, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (“*Order Granting CCN*”) authorizing MAWC to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system in the Clinton Estates service area as described in the *Order Granting CCN*. The *Order Granting CCN* set forth a schedule for filing status reports to apprise the Commission of the status of closing on the sewer system assets.
2. On July 24, 2020, MAWC filed a status report stating that the Company has been working on some easement issues in preparation for closing and expected to address the Clinton County Commission at its August 2020 meeting to resolve the remaining issues.
3. All easement issues are now resolved and MAWC’s closing on the sewer system assets is scheduled for October 1, 2020.

WHEREFORE, MAWC respectfully submits this *Status Report* to the Commission.
