Dear Mr. Roberts:

Section 536.017, RSMo. and Executive Order 93-13 require state agencies to undertake a "takings analysis" of each proposed rule or regulation to determine if the proposed rule on its face constitutes a taking of real property under relevant state and federal law. The leading case on this issue is *Lucas v. South Carolina Coastal Council*, 112 S.Ct. 2886 (1992). In *Lucas*, the Court held that state regulation that deprived an owner of real property of all beneficial economic use of that property constitutes a "taking" under the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments of the U. S. Constitution, for which the owner must be compensated.

Pursuant to the statute and order, I have completed a "takings analysis" of the above referenced proposed amended rule. The proposed amended rule clarifies the entities that must comply with the registration requirements for dealers of manufactured homes and changes a statutory citation to comport with current statutes. Nothing in this proposed amended rule deprives a regulated utility of all beneficial economic use of real property. Thus, the proposed amended rule does not implicate the takings clause of the U.S. Constitution, since it does not involve the deprivation of beneficial economic use of real property.

#### PROPOSED AMENDMENT

# 4 CSR 240-121.180 Monthly Report Requirement for Registered Manufactured Home Dealers

PURPOSE: This rule outlines the information that registered manufactured home dealers must file with the Missouri Public Service Commission and the form and manner of this filing.

- (1) Each entity registered as a manufactured home dealer must file a monthly sales report (see 4 CSR 240-120.130) with the commission no later than the tenth of the month following the month when the sales were made.
- (2) The report may be filed only upon the commission's form for monthly sales reports. These forms may be obtained from the Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, MO 65102. A copy of the required form is appended to this rule.
- (3) [The commission will reject all reports not completely and properly filled out.] The director may reject all monthly sales reports that are incomplete.
- (4) Failure to [properly complete this] submit a completed monthly report [and submit it] by the due date could result in suspension or revocation of the dealer's registration under section 700.[205]090, RSMo.
- (5) A report must be filed for each month or part of a month for which the *[person]* entity is a registered manufactured home dealer. If no sales are made in a given month, the dealer must file the usual form no later than the tenth of the following month stating no sales were made.
- (6) The report must be signed by an officer of the dealership if the dealership is a corporation; by a partner of the dealership if the dealership is a partnership; or by an owner of the dealership if the dealership is neither a corporation nor a partnership.
- (7) The dealer shall maintain a copy of this report for the records of the dealership.
- (8) Every monthly sales report shall contain the following information:
  - (A) Dealer certificate number and name;
- (B) The street address and telephone number at the actual dealership location as well as the city, state and zip code;
- (C) The date of sale for each manufactured home sold;
- (D) The sale price of each unit sold,
- (E) The size of each unit sold;
- (F) The name of the manufacturer of each unit sold as well as the year of manufacture;
- (G) The serial number from the certificate of origin for each unit sold;
- (H) Whether each unit sold is new or used;

- (I) The total number of new units sold;
- (J) The total number of used units sold;
- (K) The total sale price for all new units; and
- (L) The total sale price for all used units.

AUTHORITY: section 700.460, RSMo 1994.\* Emergency rule filed Nov. 8, 1985, effective Nov. 18, 1985, expired March 18, 1986. Original rule filed Nov. 8, 1985, effective Feb. 24, 1986. \*Original authority 1985.

PUBLIC ENTITY COST: This proposed Amendment will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than \$500 annually for the life of the rule.

PRIVATE ENTITY COST: This proposed amendment will not cost private entities more than \$500 annually for the life of the rule.

NOTICE TO SUBMIT COMMENTS: Anyone may file a statement in support of or in opposition to this proposed amendment with the Public Service Commission, Dale Hardy Roberts, Secretary, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. To be considered, comments must be received within thirty days after publication of the notice in the Missouri Register. Comments should refer to Case No. MX-2000-440, and be filed with an original and eight (8) copies. No public hearing is scheduled.
