ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Missouri Public Service Commission granted a certificate to operate private pay telephone service to Flying J Inc., in Case No. TA-98-569. On April 4, 2005, Flying J filed an application requesting that its certificate be canceled. The company stated that it has no customers in Missouri, nor does it have overdue annual reports or assessment fees.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states: “Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected” The Commission has reviewed the application and finds that the Certificate of Service Authority granted to Flying J, in Case No. TA-98-569, shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Certificate of Service Authority to provide private pay telephone service, granted to Flying J Inc., in Case No. TA-98-569, is canceled.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 15, 2005.
3. That this case may be closed on April 16, 2005.
