ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Effective Date: October 6, 2005

On September 13, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority of MAH Communications/Utelecom, L.L.C., a company that has been authorized to provide private payphone service by the Commission. Staff's motion states mail sent to the address provided by the company has been returned as undeliverable. All telephone numbers provided by the company to the Commission are now out of service. Staff indicates that the company has never provided service to Missouri customers.

Based on those facts, Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide private payphone services that was issued to the company in Case No. TA-2001-358. MAH Communications/Utelecom has not responded to Staff's motion.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2004), which states, in part: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, and on the company's failure to respond, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to MAH Communications/Utelecom should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of authority to provide private payphone services granted to MAH Communications/Utelecom, L.L.C., in Case Number TA-2001-358, is canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on October 6, 2005.
3. That this case may be closed on October 7, 2005.
