ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: November 22, 2005

Effective Date: December 2, 2005

On November 1, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide pay telephone service granted to Mays Medical Properties, Inc. The company was granted its certificate in September of 1997 in Case No. TA-98-35.

In support of its motion, Staff states that although the company is in good standing according to the Missouri Secretary of State's website, it has not returned the Commission's Statement of Revenue form for the past four years. Upon contacting the company, Staff was informed by one of the company's corporate officers that it was the intention of the company to cancel the certificate. In an e-mail to Staff, the officer notes that the company is not providing pay telephone service and does not intend to do so and requested that the certificate be canceled.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected" The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finding it reasonable shall grant the requested relief and cancel the

certificate of service authority granted to Mays Medical Properties, Inc. in Case No. TA-98-35.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's motion to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide pay telephone service, granted to Mays Medical Properties, Inc., is granted.
2. That the certificate of service authority to provide pay telephone service, granted to May Medical Properties, Inc., in Case No. TA-98-35, is canceled.
3. That this order shall become effective on December 2, 2005.
4. That this case shall be closed on December 3, 2005.
