**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and states as follows:

1. The Commission granted Davidson Telecom, LLC (“the Company”) a certificate of private pay telecommunications service authority in Case No. PA-2004-01.

2. On July 26, 2016, the Company notified the Commission that it no longer wished to retain its certification to provide telecommunications services in Missouri.

3. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

4. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel the certificate to provide private pay telecommunications service in Missouri of Davidson Telecom, LLC.
