The accompanying tariff sheet issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE or the Company), is being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued April 16, 2010 to become effective on and after May 1, 2010.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) for the Company's four Missouri service areas.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, result from a decrease in the weighted average cost of gas. The firm sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 75.00¢/Ccf to 71.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 62.55¢/Ccf to 56.80¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area is the result of a combination of a decrease in the weighted average cost of gas and a transportation charge decrease by MoGas Pipeline LLC. The firm sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 1.30/Ccf to 87.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 3.80¢/Ccf to 58.05¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing with the copy of this filing being provided to the Staff. Certain of the work papers have been designated "Highly Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where AmerenUE must compete for its gas supplies. AmerenUE requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
