COMMENTS OF THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL ON TARIFF

The Office of the Public Counsel makes the following comments to the Missouri Public Service Commission concerning Sprint Communications Company LP's tariff to extend the in-state access charge waiver promotions in this tariff.

- 1. The in-state access recovery charge was approved by the PSC in *In Re the matter of Sprint Communications Company, L. P.'s proposed tariff to introduce an instate access recovery charge and make miscellaneous text changes* (Case No. TT-2002-1136) (Tariff No. 200201020). Public Counsel opposed this charge and has appealed the PSC's decision to the Cole County Circuit Court.
- 2. One of the grounds Public Counsel based its opposition on was the separation of the essential terms, including the exemption of certain Sprint customers, in a temporary, promotional tariff while those terms did not appear in the permanent tariff.
- 3. The present tariff extends the waiver of the access charge for certain customers: "New and Existing Dial-1 Sprint accounts with no monthly Sprint long distance usage will receive a waiver of the In-State Access Recovery charge for that month. The promotion shall remain in effect until December 31, 2003, unless earlier changed or canceled by Sprint." The waiver was also extended for Standard Weekend and Option B customers.

- 4. Although Public Counsel opposes the access recovery charge in all its forms, it will not oppose this tariff in that the tariff relieves existing customers and new customers from the charge under certain conditions. The relief of customers from this unlawful, unjust, and unreasonable charge would certainly be in the public interest and protects the ratepayers.
- 5. However, Public Counsel's lack of objection to this waiver does not waiver opposition to Sprint's access recovery charge in any way.
- 6. Public Counsel also wishes to advise the Commission of certain matters related to the filing of this tariff:
 - this tariff underscores the absurdity of one-year "promotions" and the lack of the key terms and conditions of a permanent tariff.
 - this tariff underscores that this access recovery charge is nothing more that a rate element disguised as a cost recovery tool. Using the waiver of an access recovery charge as a competitive promotional feature offering shows that the company is willing to forego "cost recovery" as a competitive tool.
 - 3) Public Counsel did not receive a copy of the tariff and only learned of it from reading the Tariff Submission Report.
 - 4) The cover letter for the tariff filing is not available on the EFIS system.
 - 5) Sprint did not provide a brief summary of approximately 100 words to the effect of the change on the company's customers as required by 4 CSR 240-30.010 (25).
