# SUPPLEMENTAL PLEADING AND RESPONSE TO COMMISSION'S ORDER DIRECTING FILING

Comes now the Applicant, Lincoln County Utilities Co. and by and through their attorney, Patrick S. Flynn of Flynn & Davenport, LLC and files with the Public Service Commission its Supplemental Pleading and Response to Commission's Order Directing Filing as follows:

- 1) On March 27, 2006, Lincoln County Utilities Co. (Lincoln Utilities) filed their application with the Commission requesting authority to sell its sewer/treatment facility to the Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Lincoln County, Missouri (the Water District).
- On March 31, 2006, the Public Service Commission entered its Order
   Directing Filing to Lincoln County Utilities Co.
- 3) Lincoln County Utilities Co. states pursuant to the Commission's order that its telephone number is (573) 929-3423 and that it is without an electronic mail address or fax number and indicates such contact can be made through its counsel as indicated below.

- 4) Lincoln County Utilities Co. files herein pursuant to the Commission's order its certificate of service of its application on the Office of the Public Counsel and the General Counsel of the Commission.
- 5) Lincoln County Utilities Co. pursuant to the Commission's order will file all future pleadings according to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080.
- 6) Lincoln County Utilities Co. states at the time of the filing of the petition it was not aware of any unpaid assessments with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources as stated in paragraph 9 of its original application. Since the filing, Lincoln County Utilities Co. has been advised that there are fee's due and owing. Lincoln County Utilities Co. is without sufficient funds in which to pay such fees and has entered into an agreement with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources to pay such fees out of the closing proceeds at the time of the sale as outlined in attached Exhibit 4. Lincoln County Utilities Co. requests the Commission to approve such payment.
- 7) Applicant states that if any items required under this rule have not been met upon this application that Applicant will furnish same prior to the granting of authority sought.

Wherefore, Applicant, Lincoln County Utilities Co., prays that the Public Service Commission grant its application to sell its assets to the Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Lincoln County, Missouri.
