## REQUEST TO HOLD PENDING PROCEUDRAL SCHEDULE DECISION IN ABEYANCE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company ("UE" or "the Company") and requests the Missouri Public Service Commission ("the Commission") to hold in abeyance its decision on setting a procedural schedule in these matters. In support of this request, the Company states as follows:

- The Commission currently has before it two proposed procedural schedules; one from the Staff and one from the Company.
- 2. The Company, the Staff and the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") have reached an agreement in principle on all outstanding issues in the first sharing period of the Second Experimental Alternative Regulation Plan and have begun drafting a pleading to present to the Commission for its approval.
- 3. It is anticipated that the pleading will be similar to the "Joint Recommendation" or the "Stipulation and Agreement," which were filed at the conclusion of the first and second sharing periods, respectively, of the First Experimental Alternative Regulation Plan.

- Because of the hearing in Case No. EM-2000-292 during the week of July 10, 2000, it is not anticipated that the attorneys for the Staff, OPC and the Company will be able to finalize the settlement documents and file them until the week of July 17, 2000.
- 5. The Company suggests that if the settlement documents cannot be finalized and filed by July 21, 2000, the Company will file a notice with the Commission indicating the status of that effort and the then anticipated filing date.
- The Company has been authorized to inform the Commission that the Staff and OPC join in this request.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set out above, the Commission is requested to hold this matter in abeyance, pending the filing of settlement documents, or a further status report, by July 21, 2000.
