**REQUEST TO STAY THE FILING OF THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by its undersigned counsel and for its request to stay the filing of the procedural schedule, states to the Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

1. The Commission issued an order in Case No. SM-99-287 on April 22, 1999. This order authorized the sale of Imperial Utility Corporation's ("Imperial") sewer assets to Rock Creek Public Sewer District. Imperial and House Springs are owned and operated by the same people. The Commission conditioned the distribution of the proceeds to the owners of Imperial on the payment of House Springs' and Imperial's assessments. The parties to the Imperial sale anticipate the closing of the sale within a couple of weeks. However, the final distribution of the sale proceeds to the owners is not anticipated in the near future.


2. The Staff and House Springs have reached an agreement in principle on a stipulation and agreement for this case that will provide for the payment of the assessments upon the sale of House Springs or distribution of the proceeds from the sale of Imperial, whichever comes first.

The parties anticipate filing this stipulation and agreement prior to May 10, 1999. This will obviate the need for a procedural schedule.

WHEREFORE, the Staff and Imperial request that the Commission delay the filing of a procedural schedule until May 10, 1999.


