Comes Now the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and for its Response to

Procedural Schedule states as follows:

1. On May 31, 2000 the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed the following

Proposed Procedural Schedule:

List of Issues to be Heard, Order of Witnesses And Order of Cross-Examination	August 8, 2000
Statements of Positions	August 18, 2000
Staff and Public Counsel File Surrebuttal	August 24, 2000
Evidentiary Hearings	September 27-29,2000

2. Public Counsel supports Staff's Proposed Procedural Schedule and does not recommend that the Commission extend the Schedule any further. The sharing credits that are in dispute do not accrue interest during dependency of this matter,







and the longer it takes for this case to be resolved, the fewer AmerenUE consumers which deserve credits will actually receive those credits.

3. Public Counsel is also concerned that the proposed procedural schedule not be extended in such a way that it creates an undue hardship for its Public Counsel accounting witness Mr. Ted Robertson. Mr. Robertson is an important witness in this case and is also preparing testimony for the ongoing AmerenUE Natural Gas Rate Case, Case Number GR-2000-512.

WHEREFORE, Public Counsel respectfully requests that the Commission adopt the Staff's proposed procedural schedule as described herein.
