On January 13, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel Heartland Payphone Services' certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the state of Missouri. The Commission granted Heartland a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment in File No. TA-98-210.

The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed ten days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to file an objection or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than January 25, 2010, with:
