## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On April 27, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Tel Pro, Inc. ("Tel Pro") certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number PA-97-293, the Commission granted Tel Pro a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Tel Pro submitted a request for the Commission to cancel their certificates as the company has ceased operations and is no longer in business. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service.

On April 28, 2010, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than May 10, 2010. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Tel Pro, Inc., shall be canceled.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The certificate of authority to provide private pay telephone services granted to Tel Pro Inc., in File Number PA-97-293, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on May 22, 2010.
3. This case may be closed on May 23, 2010.
